Leader Dept Report for Board Mtg March 10, 2019

We ACLs have been busy updating our Area rosters as we lose some Leaders to retirement/moving and see some returning to our Areas as primary affiliates or are new Leaders.

Renee is guiding the retired Leaders to consider joining the Friends of LLL(basically the alumnae fb group) where they can keep in touch with LLL Activities and Leaders.

We are feeling the support of our PL Department as we turn to Hedi with breastfeeding question we are getting and requests from HCP. We are hoping that Hedi can post some of the question/answers for all of us to learn from. And we hope she will post some of the dialogs she has had with HCP requests so that we as Leaders can recognize that we have the PL Dept as a resource as well as these issues are best responded to by the PL Department in order to clearly relate the LLL Mission and Cause.
